Students participating in athletics/parking must complete **this form** and turn in the **BLUE** drug test receipt returned to the main office. Drug testing is held three times each year aligned with sport seasons located in BHS for students' convenience. Testing may also be completed at On Demand Drug Testing, 5760 Patriot Blvd., Austintown, OH 44515 (330-270-3660). Students testing at On Demand Drug Testing must present identification, inform them that they are from BHS, and **must go** after school hours. **Only participants and personnel are permitted in the testing area.**

Athletics and Driving to school are privileges, not rights. It is the responsibility of student athletes/drivers to adhere to all school regulations.

GOOD STANDING: Students must pass a yearly, required drug test and any random drug test in order to maintain good standing. This allows for representing their school teams and maintaining a parking permit. Failure to comply may result in athletic/parking penalties including, but not limited to:

1. Restrictions/penalties placed on their athletic participation.
2. A 90-day driving/parking suspension.
3. Other discipline at the discretion of the administration.

To regain privileges, students must follow school recommendations and pass the district drug test (at parent/guardian expense) at the conclusion of the parking suspension.
