Title 1
Parent Involvement Policy



The Board of Education realizes the responsibility of the schools to involve parents in the education of their children. Accordingly, the Board firmly supports the Title 1 Program requirement for parent involvement in their child's Title I Program.

The Title I staff will develop activities specifically designed to involve parents in all aspects of their child's program. These activities shall include the following:

1. An annual meeting in the fall, to which all parents of participating children are invited, to explain the Title I Program, goals, instructional activities, and parent involvement opportunities. This annual meeting may be held in conjunction with the building's regularly scheduled "open house" as long as Title 1 federal guidelines are followed.
2. Title I parents will receive a progress report(s) during the grading periods in which they are in Title I.
3. There will be a minimum of one parent-teacher conference opportunity to discuss the child's progress and placement. The regularly scheduled conference night(s) may be used for this activity.
4. There will be timely responses to all parent recommendations and/or communication.

A Parents' Advisory Committee is formed during the month of November each year to perform the following tasks:

1. Provide assistance in the planning, design, and implementation of the district's Title I Program.
2. Provide input to the building Title I staff on ways that the building's program can be strengthened.
3. Provide input on parent involvement activities and assist in the implementation of these activities when appropriate.

The Parent Advisory Committee will consist of at least one parent representative from each Title I building.
