Boardman Local Schools Parent Notifications



Teacher Professional Qualifications:

At the beginning of each school year, all Boardman parents may request the professional qualifications of their student's classroom teacher(s), including the following:

- Whether the student's teacher has met State qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction;
- Whether the student's teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which State qualifications or licensing criteria have been waived;
- Whether the student's teacher is teaching in the field of discipline of the certification of the teacher; and
- Whether the child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.

Highly Qualified Notifications:

The Boardman Schools provide to each individual parent of a child who is a student in the Title I-Part A school, with respect to the student- timely notice that the student has been assigned, or has been taught for 4 or more consecutive weeks, by a teacher who does not meet applicable State certification or licensure requirements at the grade level and subject area in which the teacher has been assigned.

State Assessments:

The Boardman Schools provide, in a mailing home to parents, information on the level of achievement of their student in each of the State's academic assessments (AIR). Parents may request, and the district provide the parents on request (and in a timely manner), information regarding any State or district policy regarding student participation in any assessments mandated by section 1111(b)(2) and by the State or district, including a policy, procedure, or parental right to opt the child out of the assessment, where applicable. Parents may request information on each assessment required by the State and/or district.
