Dear Spartan Families,

As we approach the start of the 2020-2021 school year amidst the current Coronavirus pandemic, Boardman Local Schools is planning to provide two educational options to families. Option one will provide five days of in-person instruction. Option two will include five days of remote learning at home. **If you are interested in pursuing remote learning at home for your child(ren) you must register for this option.** If you choose to utilize remote learning with your child(ren) for the first nine weeks of instruction, you must **complete and return this form by July 31st**. Students who do not register for online instruction will be placed in a traditional classroom and will not be able to register for online instruction again until the following nine weeks if needed. The remote instruction will be provided by Boardman teachers who will strive to replicate the traditional Boardman classroom education. Please be sure to reference the strict expectations required that are highlighted on the next page.

Parents/Caregivers

- Monitor student progress on coursework.
- Provide an optimal learning environment that is free from distractions (noise, pets, etc.)
- Ensure that your child is following their assigned instructional schedule.
- Communicate questions and concerns to staff during scheduled *office hours*.

Students

- This option is different from what students experienced during remote learning last spring.
- Students participating in this option will receive the Boardman curriculum.
- It is recommended students follow the schedule provided by their teacher to complete online learning, assignments, and assessments.
- The online curriculum will be aligned with state standards.
- Students will have access to courses in all core areas (English language arts, mathematics, sciences, and social studies)
- Students will also have limited access to “specials” (K-6) and elective courses (7-12).
- Students in grades 7-12 may not have access to their full schedule as planned this past spring.
- Communicate questions and concerns to staff during scheduled *office hours*.
- Students and teachers will participate in virtual check-in meetings designed to support student course progress and provide opportunities for students to connect with each other.
- Students will earn grades for their work.
- If state or local regulations require a school closure, students participating in this option will continue as scheduled and will continue to use the online curriculum and platform.
- Students in grades 7-12 who are learning remotely will only be able to participate in extracurricular activities, not co-curricular activities, like our music programs.
- Participation in inter-school athletics is subject to OHSAA eligibility requirements.

Teachers

- Teachers will provide a weekly schedule to remote students.
- Using the **Google Classroom** platform, teachers will provide instruction to students.
- Live instruction will be provided through the web-based video conferencing tool **Zoom**.
- Additional assignments will be pushed out to students for all content areas.
- Teachers will provide virtual **office hours** during the school day to meet the needs of small groups, individuals, and guardians.
- Teachers will grade work in a timely manner.
